## **HOMEConnecticut Housing Interest**

As reported by the Partnership for Strong Communities, as of 9/30/08, 65 municipalities have demonstrated interest in HOMEConnecticut housing.

**12 municipalities have already received technical assistance (TA) grants from OPM** (applications must identify the intended IHZ, Incentive Housing Zone):

East Lyme, Wallingford, Bridgeport, Plymouth, Beacon Falls, Ledyard, New Britain, Old Saybrook, Plainville, Darien, Oxford and Simsbury

**5 municipalities have passed resolutions to apply for TA grants** (their applications are being prepared):

New Canaan, Thomaston, Coventry, Tolland, and Newtown

**15 municipalities are very likely to file applications** (they are actively preparing them):

Bloomfield, Bolton, Brooklyn, Colchester, East Windsor, Hamden, Middlebury, New Haven, Portland, Redding, Stratford, Thompson, Watertown, Westbrook, Winchester

**12 municipalities probably inclined to move ahead** (Are meeting and/or invited a HOMEConnecticut representative to speak):

Ansonia, Bethel, Cheshire, Clinton, Durham, East Haddam, Ellington, Enfield, Essex, Stonington, Windsor Locks, Woodbury

**21 municipalities have more than passing interest** (have asked for additional information via phone or email and have, in many cases, scheduled meetings with a HOMEConnecticut representative):

Branford, Bristol, Brookfield, Canton, Danbury, Derby, Glastonbury, Hebron, Marlborough, Meriden, Montville, Naugatuck, New Hartford, North Haven, Norwalk, Norwich, Ridgefield, Salem, Shelton, Stamford, Trumbull.

**Developers should approach these towns NOW to explore appropriate locations where they can build the HOMEConnecticut housing the town is interested in having built.**
